



## 2009 Efficiency Updates Update



Our last news letter mentioned weatherization work performed by Central Vermont Community Action Group with the goal of reducing Park House's use of oil without sacrificing warmth. I am pleased to report that the conservative estimate of oil saved in the first winter after the work was completed was 800 gallons! This work was recommended after an energy audit performed collaboratively with Efficiency Vermont. Efficiency Ver-

mont has also provided a list of recommendations and a grant to cover a portion of the work. Pictured to the right are a sample of the 108 interior and exterior compact fluorescent light bulbs given to Park House in conjunction with this project. If all of the light fixtures using these bulbs were on at the same time, they would use 1,748 watts of electricity compared to the 7,440 watts used by comparable traditional bulbs.
